

Range Safety Regulations - 20 Yard Indoor Range

Disciplines –Bullseye, PPC, IDPA, ICORE, IPSC and Cowboy Action shooting are permitted on this Range with the following restriction:

1. **Handgun**
 - 1.1 Only .22 to .45 calibre, non-magnum, handgun loads.
2. **Rifle**
 - 2.1 Only .22 short, long and long rifle, rimfire calibres.
3. **Shotgun**
 - 3.1 Shotguns are **not permitted** on this range
4. **Black Powder**
 - 4.1 Black powder (including fixed ammunition) is **not permitted** on this range
5. **General**
 - 5.1 Shooting may take place in one (1) direction only from a firing point not-less-than ten (10) yards from the steel backstop. Shooting may take place at a reasonable angle.
 - 5.2 Centre-fire carbines, magnum loads, black powder loads, steel jacketed rounds and steel core rounds-are **prohibited**. Magnets are available to check for steel jackets and steel cores.
 - 5.3 Members and guests must sign in using the log book provided. The "Range in Use" sign must be showing while range is active.
 - 5.4 The "Red" and "Green" activity indicator lights and the Ventilation System must be used with the Range door closed during shooting activity.
 - 5.5 All shooters must ask permission of the "Range Safety Officer" to move firearms on or off the range. The "HIGH CARRY" method must be used and actions must be clear and open while being moved.
 - 5.6 Action shooters may holster their firearms after they have been cleared by the RSO.
 - 5.7 Firearms may only be loaded and unloaded on the firing line or as appropriate by the discipline being shot, with the muzzle pointed down range. All firearms must be declared "**CLEAR**" by the RSO before removal from the firing line.
 - 5.8 All firearms must be declared "**CLEAR**" by the RSO before anyone goes down range to check/change targets. No person shall be near the shooting bays while there are people downrange.
 - 5.9 In case of interruption of firing for any reason, firearms shall be unloaded and left open on the firing line bench or declared "**CLEAR**" by the RSO and holstered. Anyone can call a "Cease Fire".
 - 5.10 With the exception of shooting coaches and RSOs, all persons not firing shall stand well behind the firing line until the Range is declared "**CLEAR**". Talking behind the firing line, especially during competitions, may be distracting to other shooters and should therefore be minimized.
 - 5.11 Any person having difficulty making their firearm safe shall keep it pointed downrange and request help from the RSO.
 - 5.12 Target shooting shall be on paper targets only using the target backers and target wire hangers provided. Action Shooters may use shrouded steel targets and movable target stands for their paper/cardboard targets.
 - 5.13 All misfired cartridges shall be deposited in the steel container marked "**MISFIRES**".
 - 5.14 Shoot carefully to avoid any damage, especially to the walls and roof. Any damage noted must be reported to the Range Operator and noted in the Sign-In Log". The Range is inspected regularly for damage.
 - 5.15 Leave the range in a clean and tidy condition. Sweep the floor using sweeping compound when you are done. The use of latex gloves and a face mask is highly recommended to avoid dust/lead exposure. For the same reason, hands should be washed in cold water as soon as the clean-up is completed.

Range Safety Regulations - Range A-1 “Baffled”

(50 and 100 yards)

Disciplines - “Long-gun” shooting (from either the standing or bench-rest position, prone from position 12 only) is permitted on this range with the following restrictions:

1. Handgun

1.1 Handgun shooting is **not permitted** unless specifically authorized by the Club

2. Rifle

2.1 Centre-fire rifles calibre .17 to 50 cal

2.2 Rim-fire rifles of all calibres

3. Shotgun

3.1 Shotguns using slugs and sabot rounds may be fired under **Baffle E only**

3.2 Bird shot of any size is **not permitted**

4. Black Powder

4.1 High velocity (> 1500 fps) black powder long-guns, including modern in-line types, may be fired under **Baffle E only**

4.2 Black powder handguns are **not permitted**

5. General

5.1 The following are **prohibited**:

5.1.1 Steel targets (unless authorized by the club)

5.2 No shooting forward of the firing line is permitted unless specifically authorized by the Club.

5.3 Targets must be paper only. All bullets must travel between the upper and ground baffles and into the paper targets attached to the target backer boards. Paper targets must be at least 8 inches from the target frame posts to avoid damage. All paper targets must be removed from target boards when shooting is completed.

5.4 All shots fired must be aimed such that they impact in the target area, on the backstop. Impacts to the side berm **are not permitted**. It is viewed as “destruction of Club property” to purposely shoot at baffles, target stands or props. Such actions and will be treated accordingly. It is a serious safety offence to allow rounds to strike the range floor, any horizontal surface or to go over a backstop.

5.5 All targets and temporary stands must be taken from the range and returned to their storage area upon completion of shooting. All shell casings must be cleaned up.

Range Safety Regulations – Range A-1 “Unbaffled”

(25 to 100 yards)

Disciplines – “Long-gun” shooting (three-position and bench rest) is permitted on this range with the following restrictions:

1. Handgun

1.1 Handgun shooting is **not permitted** unless specifically authorized by the Club

2. Rifle (Long-Guns)

2.1 Rifles firing .22 short, long, long rifle, rimfire ammunition only

2.2 Black Powder “long-guns” (smooth bore and rifled) low-velocity only (<1500 fps)

3. Shotgun

3.1 Smooth bore and rifled, all bird and buck shot sizes

3.2 High-velocity (>1500 fps) slugs and sabot rounds are **not permitted**

4. Black Powder

4.1 Low velocity (< 1500 fps) black powder long-guns may be fired on this range

4.2 Black powder handguns and modern in-line rifles are **not permitted**

5. General

5.1 The following are **prohibited**:

5.1.1 all centre-fire rifle calibers

5.1.2 steel targets – unless authorized by the club

5.2 No shooting forward of the firing line is permitted unless specifically authorized by the Club.

5.3 Targets may be plastic, wood, paper or thin metal cans. Plinking is allowed as long as targets are properly placed against the backstop in a rock free area. Targets of this type (other than paper) must be removed from Club property at the end of the shooting session.

5.4 All shots fired must be aimed such that they impact in the target area, on the backstop between the range floor and ten (10) feet above the range floor. Impacts to the side berm **are not permitted**. It is viewed as “destruction of Club property” to purposely shoot at baffles, target stands or props. Such actions and will be treated accordingly. It is a serious safety offence to allow rounds to strike the range floor, any horizontal surface or to go over a backstop.

5.5 All targets and temporary stands must be taken from the range and returned to their storage area upon completion of shooting. All shell casings must be cleaned up.

Range Safety Regulations – Range A–2

(200, 300 and 400 yards)

Disciplines - “Long-gun” shooting (from either the prone or bench-rest position) is permitted on this range with the following restrictions:

1. Handgun

1.1 Handgun shooting is **not permitted** unless specifically authorized by the Club

2. Rifle

2.1 Centre-fire rifles of calibres .17 to 50 cal are permitted **except** 7.62 x 39

2.2 Rim-fire rifles of any calibre are **not permitted**

3. Shotgun

3.1 Shotguns of any type are **not permitted**

4. Black Powder

4.1 High velocity (> 1500 fps) black powder long-guns may be fired at 200 yards **only**

4.2 Black powder handguns are **not permitted**

5. General

5.1 The following are **prohibited**:

5.1.1 Steel targets (unless authorized by the Club)

5.2 No shooting forward of the firing line is permitted unless specifically authorized by the Club.

5.3 Targets must be paper only and must be placed at least 8" from target frame posts to avoid damage. All bullets must travel **BETWEEN** the baffles and into the paper targets attached to the target backer boards. All bullets must impact the back stop.

5.4 All shots fired must be aimed such that bullet travel is between the upper and lower baffles *. Impacts to the side berm **are not permitted**. It is viewed as “destruction of Club property” to purposely shoot at baffles, target stands or props. Such actions and will be treated accordingly. It is a serious safety offence to allow rounds to strike the range floor, any horizontal surface or to go over a backstop.

5.5 All targets must be removed from target boards upon the completion of shooting. All shell casings must be cleaned up.

5.6 Shooters must be able to shoot a group no larger than 4 MOA (i.e. 4 inches at 100 yards) before using this range.

Range Safety Regulations – Range A-3

(10 to 50 Yards)

Disciplines - PPC, IDPA, Cowboy Action, ICORE, IPSC, CQB and Bullseye shooting permitted on this range with the following restrictions:

1. Pistol

1.1 Only .22 to .45 cal.

2. Rifle

2.1 All above mentioned 'pistol' calibers

2.2 Only semi-auto action carbines in .223, .30 Carbine and 7.62x39 may be fired. A minimum of two members **must** be present and shooting **must** be under direct control of a Club (or one of the above discipline) certified Range Safety Officers.

3. Shotgun

3.1 All bird shot, buck shot and slugs are permitted.

4. Black Powder

4.1 Low velocity (< 1500 fps) black powder long-guns may be fired on this range

4.2 Black powder handguns up to .50 cal are permitted.

5. General

5.1 The following are **prohibited**:

5.1.1 the use of shotgun sabots

5.1.2 the use of non-shrouded steel targets;

5.1.3 the use of shoulder or cross-draw holsters

5.1.4 the use of other rifle calibers.

5.2 All holstered pistols must be unloaded unless on the firing line.

5.3 Targets may be shrouded steel, plastic, wood, paper, or thin metal cans, and they must be placed in an area free of stones, hard objects, etc. To avoid ricochets, all other targets are prohibited. All steel must be shrouded and shot from a distance of at least 10 yards.

5.4 All shots fired must be aimed such that they impact in the target area, on the backstop or side berms, between the range floor and ten (10) feet above the range floor. Impacts to the side berm must be at an angle of no more than 45 degrees from downrange.

5.5 It is viewed as “destruction of Club property” to purposely shoot at baffles, target stands or props. Such actions and will be treated accordingly. It is a serious safety offence to allow rounds to strike the range floor, any horizontal surface or to go over a backstop.

5.6 All target stands and props are to be returned to their storage area after you are finished shooting. All targets (other than paper) must be taken from the range and off the property on completion of shooting. All shell casings must be cleaned up .

Range Safety Regulations – Range B

(25 yards)

Disciplines - PPC, IDPA, ICORE, Cowboy Action, IPSC and Bullseye shooting are permitted on this range with the following restrictions:

1. Pistol

1.1 Only .22 to .45 cal.

2. Rifle

2.1 Only .22 to .45 cal. pistol calibers allowed unless otherwise authorized by the Club

3. Shotgun

3.1 All bird shot, buck shot and slugs are permitted

4. Black Powder

4.1 Low velocity (< 1500 fps) black powder long-guns may be fired on this range

4.2 Black powder handguns up to .50 cal are permitted.

5. General

5.1 The following are **prohibited**:

5.1.1 the use of shotgun sabots

5.1.2 the use of non-shrouded, steel targets.

5.1.3 the use of shoulder or cross-draw holsters.

5.1.4 the use of other rifle calibers.

5.2 All holstered pistols must be unloaded unless on the firing line.

5.3 Targets may be shrouded steel, plastic, wood, paper, or thin metal cans, and they must be placed in an area free of stones, hard objects, etc. To avoid ricochets, all other targets are prohibited. All steel must be shrouded and shot from a distance of at least 10 yards.

Range Safety Regulations – Range C

(25 yards)

Disciplines - PPC, IDPA, Cowboy Action, ICORE, IPSC and Bullseye shooting and permitted on this range with the following restrictions:

1. Pistol

1.1 Only .22 to .45 cal. plus all black powder calibers.

2. Rifle

2.1 Only the above mentioned 'pistol' calibers unless otherwise authorized by the Club

3. Shotgun

3.1 All bird shot and buck shot sizes plus slugs are permitted

4. Black Powder

4.1 Low velocity (< 1500 fps) black powder long-guns may be fired on this range

4.2 Black powder handguns up to .50 cal are permitted.

5. General

5.1 The following are **prohibited**:

5.1.1 the use of shotgun sabots

5.1.2 the use of non-shrouded, steel targets.

5.1.3 the use of shoulder or cross-draw holsters.

5.1.4 the use of other rifle calibers.

5.2 All holstered pistols must be unloaded unless on the firing line.

5.3 Targets may be shrouded steel, plastic, wood, paper, or thin metal cans, and they must be placed in an area free of stones, hard objects, etc. To avoid ricochets, all other targets are prohibited. All steel must be shrouded and shot from a distance of at least 10 yards.

Range Safety Regulations – Bunker Range

(25 yards)

Disciplines - PPC, IDPA, ICORE, Cowboy Action, IPSC and Bullseye shooting are permitted on this range with the following restrictions:

1. Pistol

1.1 Only .22 to .50 cal plus all black powder calibers.

2. Rifle

2.1 Only .22 to .45 cal. pistol calibers allowed unless otherwise authorized by the Club

3. Shotgun

3.1 The use of shotguns is **not permitted** on this range

4. Black Powder

4.2 Black powder long guns are **not permitted**.

4.1 Black powder handguns up to .50 cal. are permitted.

5. General

5.1 The following are **prohibited**:

5.1.1 the use of non-shrouded, steel targets.

5.1.2 the use of shoulder or cross-draw holsters.

5.1.3 the use of other rifle calibers.

5.2 All holstered pistols must be unloaded unless on the firing line.

5.3 Targets may be shrouded, reactive steel, (or non-shrouded steel if placed inside the bunker) plastic, wood, paper, or thin metal cans and they must be placed in an area free of stones, hard objects, etc. to avoid ricochets. All steel must be shot from a distance of at least 10 yards. All other targets are **prohibited**.

5.4 All shots fired must be aimed such that they impact in the target area, on the backstop or side berms, between the range floor and ten (10) feet above the range floor. Impacts to the side berm must be at an angle of no more than 45 degrees from downrange.

5.5 It is viewed as “destruction of Club property” to purposely shoot at baffles, target stands or props. Such actions and will be treated accordingly. It is a serious safety offence to allow rounds to strike the range floor, any horizontal surface or to go over a backstop.

5.6 All target stands and props are to be returned to their storage area after you are finished shooting. All targets (other than paper) must be taken from the range and off the property on completion of shooting. All shell casings must be cleaned up .

Range Safety Regulations – Shepherd Range

(50 yards)

Note: *Agencies renting this range (with dates/times booked on club calendar) have priority of use.*

Disciplines. PPC, IDPA, ICORE, Cowboy Action, IPSC, CQB and Bullseye shooting are permitted on this range with the following restrictions:

1. Pistol

1.1 .22 cal. to .45 cal.

2. Rifle

2.1 All above mentioned pistol calibers

2.2 Only semi-auto action carbine in .223, .30 Carbine and 7.62x39 may be fired. A minimum of two members **must** be present and shooting **must** be under direct control of a Club or one of the above discipline-certified Range Safety Officer.

3. Shotgun

3.1 All bird shot, buck shot and slugs are permitted

4. Black Powder

4.1 Low velocity (< 1500 fps) black powder long-guns may be fired on this range

4.2 Black powder handguns up to .50 calibers are permitted.

5. General

5.1 The following are **prohibited**:-

5.1.1 shooting from under the canopy

5.1.2 the use of shotgun sabots

5.1.3 the use of non-shrouded steel targets;

5.1.4 the use of shoulder or cross-draw holsters

5.1.5 the use of other rifle calibers.

5.2 All holstered pistols must be unloaded unless on the firing line.

5.3 Targets may be shrouded steel, plastic, wood, paper, or thin metal cans, and they must be placed in an area free of stones, hard objects, etc. To avoid ricochets, all other targets are prohibited. All steel must be shrouded and shot from a distance of at least 10 yards.

5.4 All shots fired must be aimed such that they impact in the target area, on the backstop or side berms, between the range floor and ten (10) feet above the range floor. Impacts to the side berm must be at an angle of no more than 45 degrees from downrange.

5.5 It is viewed as “destruction of Club property” to purposely shoot at baffles, target stands or props. Such actions and will be treated accordingly. It is a serious safety offence to allow rounds to strike the range floor, any horizontal surface or to go over a backstop.
